- 13.a **Quinta De São Cristóvão White 2008** Portugal £15.25
Citric-yellow colour, with clearness and brightness. Strong impression of flowers and white fruits (peach and apricot) in the nose from Fernão Pires, balanced by a crisp minerality of Arinto. Good balance between structure, acidity and alcohol.
- 13.b **Quinta De São Cristóvão Rose 2008** Portugal £15.25
Bright and clear red colour. Aromas of cherry and strawberries in jelly from Aragones and Syrah, with slight floral notes of violets- Touriga Nacional. Freshness in the mouth, good acidity and well balanced sweetness that turns it very easy drinkable and pleasant
- 13.c **Quinta De São Cristóvão Red 2006** Portugal £15.25
Medium deep red colour. Intense nose of red fruits jam and some spice, revealing youth. Medium-bodied with round structure and supple tannin. Red wine for every-day meals.

- 14 **VIA NOVA, PINOT GRIGIO BLUSH** Italy £16.25
Salmon pink in colour with an aromatic nose of freshly crushed cranberries and mineral elements. The palate is light, dry and crisp, with a delicious balance between zingy citrus and fruity red berry flavours. Very easy to drink, finishing clean and refreshing.
- 15 **DE GRAS, ZINFANDEL ROSÉ** Chile £17.50
A full palate of pink grapefruit, pomegranate, and honey, with a hint of spiciness in the after taste. Nicely fresh and crispy with a lingering finish.
- 16 **CHÂTEAU LA FREYNELLE, BORDEAUX CLAIRET.** France £21.75
Brilliant deep pink colour with an aromatic nose reminiscent of red fruit (strawberry and cherry). Very elegant palate with a good balance between freshness, vigour, delicacy and red fruit with a clean, crisp finish.

<i>Pale yellow in colour with a touch of complexity on the nose brought about by ageing on the lees. The palate is well balanced with surprisingly good weight and concentration followed by a clean, crisp finish.</i> | France | £18.25 |
| 19 | CECCHI, ORVIETO CLASSICO.
<i>This Orvieto Classico is characterised by a pale straw colour and an evident aromatic profile, representative of its grape variety which is intense and well structured. The wine is dry, well balanced and refreshing.</i> | Italy | £18.35 |
| 20 | LE VIGNE LE COSTE, SOAVE CLASSICO.
<i>Fresh and zesty, with pleasant citrus fruit flavours and balanced acidity, Le Vigne's Soave Classico is full and elegant with a delicious hint of fresh fruit.</i> | Italy | £19.50 |

| 25 | WILLEMS, RIESLING SCHIEFER TROCKEN.
<i>This Riesling is bright; light lemon yellow in the glass and invitingly fresh on the nose. On the palate it has a vibrant minerality and refreshing streak of acidity leading into a long finish.</i> | Germany | £26.50 |
| 26 | DOMAINE DU CHARDONNAY, PETIT CHABLIS.
<i>A bright, elegant Petit Chablis with traditional crisp minerality and refreshing citrus-like acidity. Beautifully balanced</i> | France | £27.25 |
| 27 | CHÂTEAU FAVRAY, POUILLY FUMÉ.
<i>Not just a grassy, acidic dry white but a round, lush wine with depth of fruit and fantastic concentration, and superb balance which make it an ideal Sauvignon Blanc. 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- 31 TAPANAPPA, TIERS VINEYARD CHARDONNAY. Australia £77.50
The aroma is complex but more nectarine than peach and the flavours are more latent although very intense and with high natural acid even after malo-lactic fermentation. This is a wine that opens up in the glass and will benefit from time in bottle.
- 32 DOMAINE MICHELOT MEURSAULT 1ER CRU CHARMES. France £87.50
Minerals, citrus and understated ripe tropical fruits are found on the nose. Shows a clean and lifted palate with pineapple, peach and pear fruit and spicy vanilla alongside limey acidity on the elegant and very lengthy finish.

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| 33 | PAGOS DE ARÁIZ, CRIANZA NAVARRA.
<i>The nose is aromatic with a medium to high intensity. Fruits such as blackberry, raspberry and plums are detected alongside a well-integrated toasty character. After some time in the glass, liquorice and vanilla and a touch of greenness can be found. The palate is complex, still tannic and with a high but balanced acidity. The long length can be justified by an almost perfect amount of fruit and oak. Medium bodied and very structured.</i> | Spain | £17.50 |
| 34 | PETER LEHMANN MY WORD IS MY BOND, SHIRAZ.
<i>Deep garnet rim with a black centre. Lashings of dark chocolate on the nose. Showing the classic richness of Barossa Shiraz with a superb depth of fruit on the middle palate reined in by fine chalky tannins on the finish.</i> | Australia | £19.50 |
| 35 | LIRAC, CHATEAU MONT REDON, RHONE
<i>A wine similar in style as Chateauneuf-du-Pape, but more accessible. Full bodied blend of Grenache, Syrah, Mourvedre, Cinsault grapes with great flavours and aftertaste</i> | France | £19.50 |
| 36 | PASCUAL TOSO MALBEC.
<i>The nose is clean and fruitful. Its aromas are reminiscence of plums & quince with a little touch of elegant oak. The mouth has a mild bouquet, blackberry and liquorice fruit that keeps a firm grip through the finish.</i> | Argentina | £21.75 |
| 37 | INTRIGA, CABERNET SAUVIGNON.
<i>A deep ruby red colour with purple notes. Loaded with ripe black fruit and cassis, touches of mocha and mint, all surrounded by elegant spice and vanilla. Ripe concentrated fruity flavours, with chocolate and mocha, sweet oak and a great balance. A long lasting finish.</i> | Chile | £22.00 |
| 38 | LE VIGNE, VALPOLICELLA CLASSICO.
<i>Bright ruby red in colour with a palate full of ripe, red cherry and succulent, plum fruit flavours.</i> | Italy | £22.85 |
| 39 | DOMAINE BRUSSET, CÔTES DU RHÔNE.
<i>Ruby red in colour with enticing aromas of red berry fruits. The palate is round, with subtle flavours of raspberries and other red fruits. The wine is well balanced and the tannins smooth and approachable.</i> | France | £23.50 |
| 40 | PIERRE SOURDAIS, CHINON TRADITION.
<i>Soft and supple with juicy fruit flavours, this mouth filling wine has ripe tannins and an elegant finish, a remarkable Chinon</i> | France | £26.00 |
| 41 | EBANO 6, RIBERA DEL DUERO.
<i>Intense, almost opaque ruby core with a purple rim on first release, this powerful young wine shows a highly fruity nose of ripe blackberries, ripe plums and strawberries. The mineral notes of the terroir, and a hint of fresh greenness work wonderfully as a foil to the exuberant fruit. On the palate there is a medium to full bodied mouth feel with powerful structure given by warm, ripe tannins.</i> | Spain | £26.50 |
| 42 | CHÂTEAU DES GRAVIÈRES, COLLECTION PRESTIGE GRAVES.
<i>Deep garnet-red with a slightly woody and toasted nose and aromas of prunes and liquorice. Fleshy, robust and well-balanced in the mouth with a firm, lengthy finish.</i> | France | £27.50 |
| 43 | CECCHI, CHIANTI CLASSICO.
<i>This Chianti Classico is characterised by an intense, ruby red colour, which tends towards garnet with ageing. On the nose it is full and rich, characterised by hints of violets. On the palate it is balanced with great structure allied to fine fruit</i> | Italy | £28.00 |
| 44 | LOUIS TÊTE, FLEURIE.
<i>Wonderfully perfumed with juicy, ripe sweetness, cherry and chocolate flavours and a raspberry finish, with a touch of spiciness.</i> | France | £29.00 |
| 45 | BOURGOGNE PINOT NOIR, CHÂTEAU DE LA CHARRIÈRE.
<i>Light ruby red in the glass this shows clean varietal aromas of strawberries, raspberries and a hint of hay. In the mouth it is medium-bodied, with balanced, fresh acidity and light tannins. Basic Burgundy at its best.</i> | France | £31.00 |



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| 46 | MARQUÉS DE RISCAL, RIOJA RESERVA.
<i>A dark cherry colour with good depth. Balsamic aromas with hints of ripe fruit, complex and spicy. The attack is fresh and light, with soft, rounded tannins. The finish proves persistent with some reminders of toasted oak. Its passage through the mouth is pleasant and elegant, fresh and easy to drink.</i> | Spain | £31.50 |
| 47 | CHÂTEAU PEY LA TOUR RESERVE, BORDEAUX.
<i>Mellow nose, with aromas of dense, fleshy fruit. Tasty and rich, with surprising concentration, good purity and depth, low acidity and plump fleshy fruit. Solid mouth feel and excellent length.</i> | France | £34.25 |
| 48 | CHÂTEAU D'ARCIE, GRAND CRU, ST EMILION.
<i>Deep ruby red in the glass this shows plums and pencil lead on the nose. Delicious clean and fruity palate, with damsons, black fruit and refreshing hints of pepper and chocolate on the finish. A clean, attractive and modern-style claret, with the added bonus of being accessible when young.</i> | France | £40.50 |
| 49 | TAPANAPPA FOGGY HILL PINOT NOIR.
<i>The flavours are delicate sweet and spicy and are balanced against the tannin and acid without the interference of alcohol – it is as though the wine is built around its water component. The tannins are significant, but soft and savoury, and the whole wine is melded into a complex fabric of aromas, flavours, tastes and texture, which is seamless.</i> | Australia | £43.75 |
| 50 | DOMAINE FERNAND, NUITS-ST-GEORGES.
<i>Attractive ruby colour with plenty of summer fruit flavours such as cherries, and strawberries. Elegant with very good structure.</i> | France | £44.85 |
| 51 | CHATEAUNEUF DU PAPE, DOMAINE CHANTE CIGALE.
<i>Deep ruby in colour with a wonderful nose of spice and dark fruits this is a real winter warmer. The palate is rich and ripe with layers of fruit and spice supported by fine tannins.</i> | France | £56.00 |
| 52 | RODA, RIOJA RESERVA.
<i>The wine shows aromas of crushed red cherries and savoury herbs, and ripe, spicy and structured fruit on the palate, with soft tannins and a long finish.</i> | Spain | £58.50 |
| 53 | CHATEAU D'ARSAC, CRU BOURGEOIS, MARGAUX.
<i>Intense garnet-red in colour with a toasty, smoky nose, opening up to reveal a generous bouquet of red fruits. Silky and seductive palate, structured but rounded, with a concentrated middle and a flourish of vanilla and blackcurrant on the finish</i> | France | £60.00 |
| 54 | TAPANAPPA WHALEBONE VINEYARD CABERNET SHIRAZ.
<i>“This wine seems to straddle the Old and New Worlds; it's ripe but not excessively so, and there is integrated oak and subtle spice. In the mouth it's smooth and sleek, with a polished texture and flavours of summer pudding rather than just cassis.</i> | Australia | £67.50 |
